## La violence ne fait pas partie des valeurs autochtones



## **BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE TOOL:**

This kit is for the victims and all of those who are in contact with victims of marital or family violence. It consists of five sheets. The first relates to domestic violence and its manifestations and identifies the cycles of violence. The second shows the effects of domestic violence to better understand the victim and her reactions to violence. The third addresses the needs of victims, in conjunction with the various phases of questioning experienced by the victim: questioning oneself, challenging the violent behavior, and questioning the relationship. The fourth sheet calls for the support of community and family, telling them what resources can assist and support the victim in her efforts and what services are offered by the shelters for Native women. Finally, the fifth sheet suggests to witnesses of domestic violence some practical interventions to help victims and ensure their protection.
