BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE TOOL:

This tool results from a partnership between RIFVEL and the City of Montreal Police. This abuse risk assessment tool is based on the work by Mr. Louis Plamondon and on his tool ODIVA 360 (www.rifvel.org) and was adapted to the context of police work. Using this form, police officers called to respond to an event involving a senior pay special attention to indicators of potential abusive situations. If the situation requires a psychosocial intervention, the officer will form a partnership with a service worker from the CSSS.

The tool consists of two sections:

- 1) An ODIVA-Police form, including indicators to identify victims and abusers
- 2) A guide for the implementation of the pilot project in a police department or district, which includes the responsibilities assigned to various police
