

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE TOOL:**

This manual is the result of a research project conducted in Montreal, where the objective was to develop an intervention model to prevent and solve the problems of violence often suffered by seniors.

In this book, the authors demonstrate the effectiveness of their screening and intervention method with elderly victims of neglect and abuse.

Using case histories, they illustrate the implementation of various aspects of their approach.

Their model includes seven components including: rules for detecting and describing a situation of violence; response teams composed of experts; multidisciplinary teams and home care teams; volunteer assistants; accountability support group; and a community committee on violence against seniors.
