BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE TOOL:

This play presents a page in the life story of Arthur, which is similar to what some seniors also live. The various characters -- Albert the neighbor, Pete the salesman, Arthur's son Philip, and the police -- show, in their own way, various situations in which seniors can find themselves.

"This project aims primarily to encourage seniors of all social classes to denounce the abuses against them or against other seniors and also to raise awareness of different realities experienced by elderly victims of fraud, abuse, solicitation, but also of their own silence. The piece serves as a trigger for the denunciation of certain malicious acts "(Théâtre poivre et sel: project summary).
